## **Mounting Instructions**

## Congratulations on your purchase of a quality product!

Fabric Wall Stickers have a special coating that adheres to nearly every surface imaginable - including dry wall, concrete, glass, wood and masonry. The only tools necessary are paper towels and a light surface and window cleaner. Please follow these recommended instructions for best mounting results.

## Installation

- STEP 1: Prior to mounting your Fabric Wall Sticker, gently clean the display area with a light surface and window cleaner. Wipe clean moisture and residue, and allow surface to thoroughly dry. WARNING! Oil and moisture can cause damage to the decal adhesive.
- STEP 2: Remove the fabric wall decal from the shipping container. Use the orientation of your banner as a guide (i.e. horizontal or vertical) and remove the backing from the top of your sticker and affix corners first. We recommend that you mount from top to bottom. Remember...clean your hands prior to mounting decal, and save shipping container.
- STEP 3: When satisfied your Fabric Wall Sticker is level, completely remove the decal backing. Then gently lower onto desired area.
- STEP 4: Using Paper Towels, press the sticker into place from the center out, smoothing any bubbles. Make certain all corners are pressed into place.
- STEP 5: For difficult bubbles...<u>carefully lift the affected area ONLY and reapply</u>.

## Removal or storage

- STEP 1: Select another clean surface area for display or storage.
- STEP 2: Place hands on top corners of sticker, and pull downward gently. Exercise care, and do not allow banner backing to touch other areas. Take your time, this is the most difficult part.
- STEP 3: Then follow Installation Steps (1-5)
